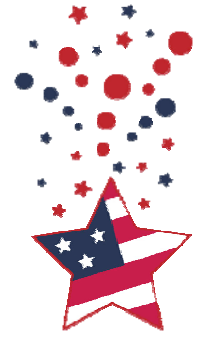




4th of July & Fireworks Celebrations in Lancaster County
